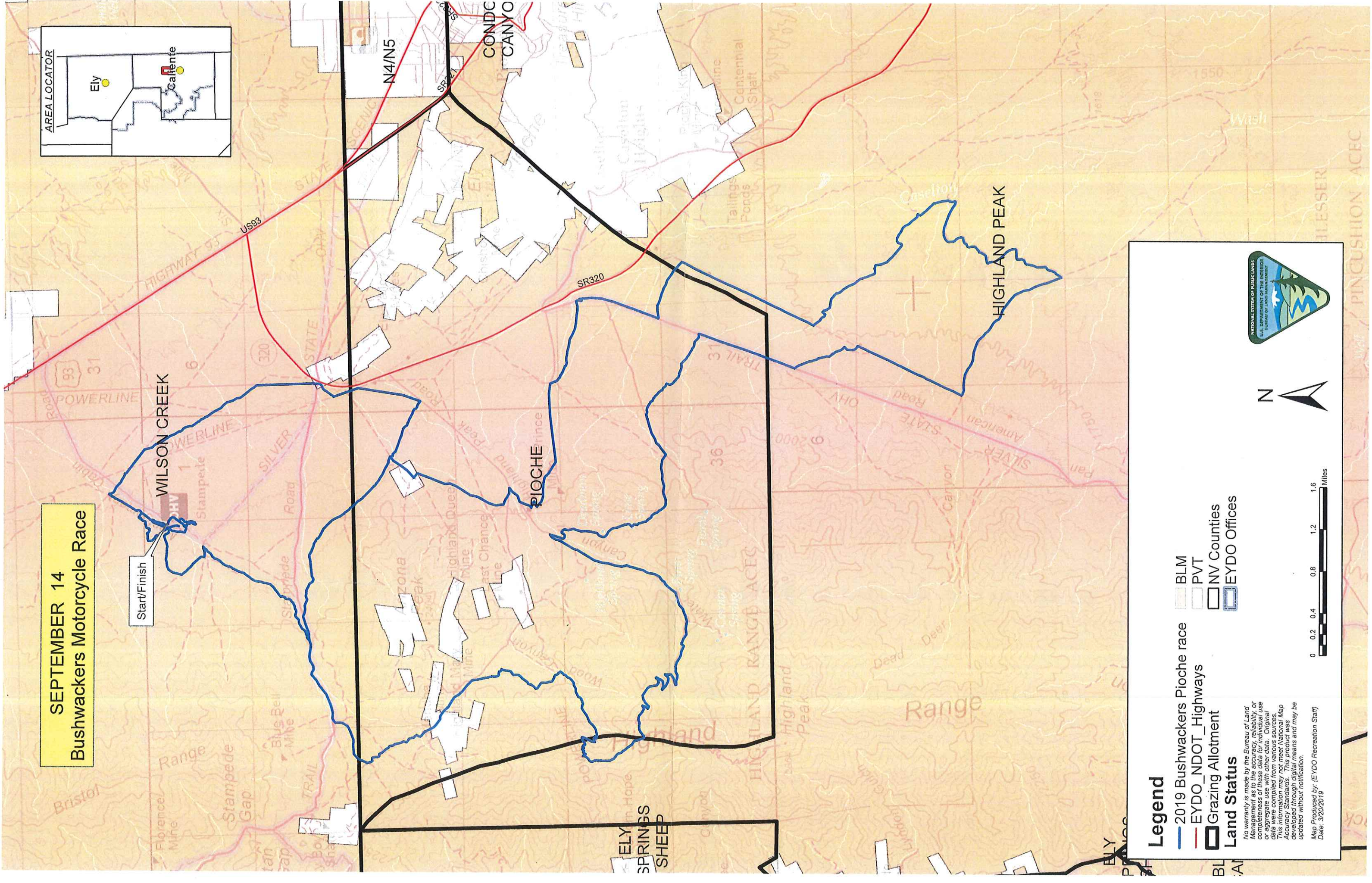
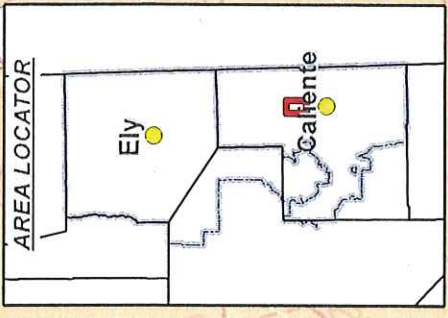

Dear Interested Public:

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Caliente Field Office has received, and is processing, an application for a renewal of a Special Recreation Permit for the Bushwackers Motorcycle Club. The event would take place on September 14, 2019. Motorcycle only race, Pioche Hare Scrambles. The main pit (Start/Finish) would be located at the Silver State Trail Stampede Trail Head, see attached map. Four separate races would take place on Saturday September 14, 2019: The Bushwackers anticipate 100-130 participants and 100 spectators. The event would occur within the following grazing allotments, Wilson Creek, Pioche, and Highland Peak. The event consists of the following:

- The First race would be all Open Mini, 85cc and the 65cc classes. They would start at approximately 7:30 am and race for 1 hour and 30 minutes. The race course is approximately 10 miles in length.
- The second race would be the 50cc class. They would start at approximately 9:15 am and race approximately for 45 minutes. The race course is located entirely in the gravel pit area.
- The third race would be the 65 novices and 50cc expert and amateur classes. They would start at approximately 10:00 am and race for approximately 45 minutes. The race course is located entirely in the gravel pit area.
- The fourth race would be all Big Bikes. They would start approximately 11:30 am. They would race a maximum of 2 laps. The race course is approximately 36 miles in length.
